

#### **About Our Program**

This Japan Exchange Program accepts students from overseas every year in cooperation with the Board of Education of Ibaraki Prefecture, which is about an hour from central Tokyo by express train. This program does not earn credits, but students live at school with Japanese students, stay with volunteer host families, integrate into the community, and enjoy a true Japanese experience. We welcome students who want to learn more about Japan, a country with a culture and history unique in the world!



#### **Entry Qualifications**

- ★Aged between 14.5 and 18 years old.
- ★ Have a good academic record, particularly in the last 2 years.
- ★Be in good physical and mental health.
- ★Be willing to accept our program, school, and homestay family rules
- ★Be willing to become a great ambassador of their home country, showing good manners, honesty and moral values.



#### **Program Fee Not Includes**

- ★Return International ticket, to Narita Airport
- ★Student visa and visa fees, if required
- ★Travel with host family in Japan
- ★Stationery and school uniform, allow approximately US\$800 for these expenses; the amount may vary
- ★Optional extra subjects, such as School Outdoor Education
- ★Pocket money, allow between US\$50 per week.
- ★Commuter pass (based on distance to school)
